Can *Bletilla striata* be grown indoors?

Bletilla striata is hardy down to a temperature of 25°F (-3.5°C). May be best to lift plants once they are dormant and store indoors in a frost free area. An alternative is to grow *Bletilla* in containers and bring them indoors for the winter. Propagate: clumps can be divided once flowering has finished.

How do you grow a *Bletilla* plant?

Here are some growing tips for *Bletilla*: Location: *Bletilla* prefers a location with partial shade, though they can tolerate full sun in cooler climates. Soil: They require well-draining soil. A mixture of garden soil and compost works well. The soil pH should ideally be slightly acidic to neutral.

Can *Bletilla* be planted outside?

Bletilla are half hardy perennials and can tolerate temperatures down to between -5°C to -10°C. They can be planted directly outside between March and May providing the weather is mild, if it is possible that temperatures will dip lower than -5°C it is safest to start them off in a cool greenhouse.
