Should lockers sit back-to-back?

Your lockers should sit back-to-back in order to make the most of your space. Will you need space for benches? If so, it's a good idea to leave at least 1.5m of space between lockers. But if your lockers are just for staff to store their belongings during their shift, 1.2m should be enough space for lockers that are face-to-face.
