complete and checked. When a staircase is being installed it must be temporarily guarded until full installation has taken place to prevent danger to those working nearby. Temporary guarding must comply with EN 13374:2004. Protecting the stair: After installation, the stair must be protected from damage prior to building handover.

As seen above, the installation of a staircase (whether they are tansu storage stairs, or a simpler staircase) depends on the overall length that is available to achieve the required height. If your loft space is positioned higher than normal, you might find that you would need over 110" (280cm) of free space to build a suitable staircase.
