Can you install solar panels on your roof?

Homes and businesses will be able to install rooftop solar panels more easily, under new rules announced today. Changes to permitted development rights rules will mean more homeowners and businesses will be able to install solar panels on their roofs without going through the planning system.

Can a business install solar panels on a flat roof?

Businesses are already allowed to install solar panels on flat roofs and will soon be able to install panels that generate more than one megawatt of electricity without permission. These changes have been introduced to make it smoother for solar panels to be installed as car park canopies, said the government.

Are solar panels paying rent for your roof?

All solar photovoltaic (PV) systems require an Electrical Permit and, in some rare cases*, a Building Permit. *Note: If you do not qualify for the Building Permit Exemption (Section 3 of the checklist linked to below) you will need to apply for both a Building Permit and a separate Electrical Permit.

Along with orientation, the size of your roof will determine how many solar panels you can install. The average US home solar system size is 5 kilowatts or 12-13 panels with a rating of 400 Watts. With solar panels requiring about 15 square feet each, you need about 200 square feet of (south- or west-facing) roof space to fit 13 panels on your ...

The two main types of panels are photovoltaic panels and solar thermal panels; photovoltaic panels will convert thermal energy into electricity, and solar thermal panels turn solar energy into heat. These can be used in conjunction with each other, but some financial aid schemes are applicable only to certain panel types.
