Is solar dryer suitable for all clothes?

Do you need clothespins for a clothes drying rack?

If you're using a clothes drying rack outdoors, you will need clothespins. Permanent clotheslines can be set up indoors or outside if you need more drying space than your clothes drying rack can afford. A seasonal or temporary clothesline can be hung inside using a piece of rope and some sturdy hooks - we've done that before!

Should I install a dryer or a solar system?
