

# Replace the alternator belt of Fengjun 7

How much does alternator belt replacement cost?

The alternator belt replacement cost (also known as serpentine belt, v-belt, drive belt or fan belt) are made up of material costs (approx. £20 - £30) and labour costs (approx. £60 - £200). For most vehicles, costs of around £80 - £230 can be expected.

Do I need to change the alternator belt?

In most cases it is sufficient to change only the alternator belt (or serpentine belt) and there are no additional costs. Occasionally, however, an additional change of alternator belt tensioner and pulley makes sense, as the material costs are low compared to the labour costs.

How long does alternator belt replacement take?

The average alternator belt replacement time will take roughly between 30 - 60 minutes, provided that no further work is necessary. The alternator belt replacement is therefore surprisingly fast when compared to other car repairs. A big advantage when changing is the easy access to the alternator belt.

How do I Change my alternator?

Locate your alternator and the alternator belt. Loosen it, and then remove it. Check the condition of the belt; if it is too worn, you should consider replacing it. Rebranchez les connectiques. How do you fix a loose alternator wire?

Tuck the loose wire aside so it doesn't snag on the alternator when you remove it. Relieve tension on the belt with the auto-tensioner (if equipped). Some vehicles use the alternator itself to apply tension to the serpentine or accessory belt, but others use an auto tensioner pulley.

What happens if the alternator belt fails?

⋮; The electronics may fail The alternator belt also drives the alternator and this starts the car battery. Without the alternator, electric accessories such as A/C, radio or plugs will only run on the remaining energy of the car battery.

7) You should be able to see the alternator easily now. You will then remove 3 bolts and 1 nut on the alternator. 1 bolt and the nut are accessed through the wheel well (should be easily visible). We used a couple extensions to access the bolt through the wheel well.

Using a 3/8 ratchet without a socket on it place it in the 3/8 square on the face of the belt auto tensioner. then apply force to relieve tension on the belt, then pop the belt off of one of the pulleys, Power steering pulley for example. removing the alternator on these cars is no easy task just because of the sheer lack of room.

Every project has a tough spot, and this is the tough spot for alternator replacement: remove the belt from the pulley. Somewhere on your vehicle there is a tensioner pulley. You'll need to move it enough to slip the belt off the pulley. Our '95 GMC has a standard spring-loaded GM tensioner that required us to pull it back with a wrench.

With your water pump belt, you have to take off the alternator belt 1st to tension. Slacken off the alternator belt by loosening the hinge bolt and slide bracket tensioner. Take off the water pump pulley with the bolts in a triangular formation. The pulley comes off in three parts; Side 1, side 2 and spacer discs.

With any drive belt, there's a pivot bolt for whatever component you're trying to replace the belt for, there's an adjuster lock nut and then finally an adjuster bolt. You first have to loosen the pivot bolt for the alternator (basically the bolt that holds the alternator to the engine) so the alternator can move freely.

Common faulty alternator signs. Battery warning light - The battery warning light on your dashboard turns

on.. Dimming lights - Headlights, dashboard lights, or interior lights flicker or appear noticeably dim, especially when idling or driving at low speeds.. Strange noises - Unusual whining or grinding noises can suggest a failing alternator belt or component failure.

Guide the belt up around the topside of the AC pulley and then partially hook it around the Alternator pulley. 9) \*\*\*Now check your work\*\*\*. Make sure that the belt is properly seated on all pulleys (except the alternator). Once satisfied that all is in order squeeze the belt completely over the alternator pulley.

Disconnect batteries. There is constant 12v running to the larger positive cable to the alternator from the batteries. Using a 1/2 drive ratchet or breaker bar, loosen the belt tensioner and slip the belt off the top center pulley. Using a 13mm socket or wrench, remove the top mounting bolt for the lower alternator.
