What is a performance warranty on a solar panel?

Performance warranties guarantee a percentage of electric power output over the warranty period. Most solar manufacturers offer 25-year performance warranties. The amount of power your solar panel can output declines steadily over that period.

While manufacturer warranties primarily cover issues related to the solar panels themselves, such as material defects, workmanship defects, and loss of power output, the solar installation warranty extends additional protection to the entire photovoltaic system.

Why are solar panel warranties important?

Solar panel warranties are important to make sure you get the expected electricity savings over time. For example, if your solar energy system is expected to save at least \$1,200 per year, a 25-year warranty means you get \$30,000 in guaranteed savings. Solar panel warranties also help you qualify for favorable loan conditions.

How do I get a solar panel warranty?

Generally, the most robust warranties are obtained by hiring installation companies certified by the solar brands they represent. Alternatively, long warranties can also be secured from solar manufacturers that provide their own installation services. What Is Not Covered by a Solar Panel Warranty?

How long do solar panels last?

Workmanship and materials warranty of one or two years. Batteries (non-grid systems / hybrids) roughly 5-15 years. Inverter (s) warranty of between 5-10 years. There are many factors that must be borne in mind when considering warranties for your solar panel system.

A performance warranty is a guarantee that your solar panels will maintain a certain output over a determined time period. An article on What Does Solar Panel Efficiency Mean states, "Typically, a performance warranty will guarantee 90% production for the first ten years and 80% for up to 25 years" (goingsolar).
